Greetings to each of you. We are grateful that fall has arrived and with it cooler temperatures. As I write this I just recently arrived in Pergamino, Argentina. Just a couple of weeks ago we received word from one of our church members that our house had been broken into. Before I got here it had happened again. After contacting the neighbors, they told us that they had stopped a family from trying to take over our house twice now. So I flew down here to see what we could do about the situation and encourage the Lord's people. We thank the Lord that what was stolen, although of significant value, can be replaced and that we still have a house. You see, if a single mother with her children were to get into our house, we would basically lose it; ***in Argentina squatters rights exist and are recognized!*** I ask that you pray with me for wisdom and patience as I deal with the authorities here and decide what to do to try and keep this from happening again.



It will be so good to be with our friends again here and to encourage each other in the Lord! I have already received invitations from other churches to come and visit them while I am here. Our people need much encouragement but we commend them to God's grace and to His word.

Our oldest son Caleb has just joined the US Army as an interpreter. He will go to Basic Training at the end of February. He is ready to get on with his life here in the US as a young adult and this will be a good start for him. We pray that he will allow the Lord to have a place in his life and we ask you to pray for him as well. Also, ***this will allow us to return to Argentina in March.*** Until then we will visit churches and raise much needed support. God has always been good to us and has provided for our every need and we trust that He will do so again. The inflation rate here continues to be more than 20% and we have seen a sizable decline in our support this year. So we ask that you will pray with us for God's continued provision.

Lastly, I ask that you pray for us and for the other missionaries here in Argentina. Just this past couple of days the government here has announced new policies in an effort to try and control the economy. These policies will effect the way we will be able to get dollars while here in Argentina and will effect our ability to purchase property in the future. This will make it more difficult for the missionaries here overall. However, **God is still on the throne!**
