My dear wife Beverly was diagnosed with uterine cancer in June. She had a complete hysterectomy on July 1st. Seth and Heather, my son and daughter-in-law, were up visiting and were a great help during this time. The doctors said the cancer was contained in the uterus, that's the good news. The bad news is that the uterus fell apart while they were removing it during surgery, falling into her body cavity, and the question is will it go to seed? Now that she is healing well, thanks to GOD and your prayers, I am asking for more prayer in her behalf. We just came back from a doctor's appointment in Anchorage, Alaska at the Radiation Therapy Center. Very nice folk. There are three things that I want to share with you. Beverly needs to have a PET/CT scan that will determine "IF" there is seeding going on; if the cancer that dropped down has gone to seed and is alive. If so, she will undergo 25 radiation treatments plus one more special treatment. Please pray for her. We do not have insurance; any help in this regard will be appreciated.

Jeffery has broken his probation and is in Jail. He cannot get out on bail. His court date is Sept 27th unless things change. Eskimo Missions continues!! Ephrim and his wife Jaelene, Jeffery's sister, came out to Fairbanks from the village of Kalskag and were with us in our services. They were happy to be with us. Do you remember when we reported driving down the river to Bethel when it was iced over? We went to the home of Logan Tetoff. Jeffery was instrumental in us going there. Logan was saved by the Grace of our LORD and is still serving God. They sent us 400 dollars to come back out. We need to get back out there!! Mosaic Baptist, brother Raleigh Campbell Jr., sent us 1500 dollars. We now have 2900 dollars in our travel fund. Summer fishing is about over, hunting will begin early September and end late September. Right now the best time for us to go out is late fall, winter and spring. People will be home during these times. We love it, pray for us. Pray for Jeffery!!!

I am doing Bible studies with Bro. Logan, plus we send out DVD's of our services in Fairbanks to 5 different villages. Please keep the village ministry in prayer. There are many villages that need the Gospel!!! We are JUST BEGINNING! Praise the LORD!!!!

Continue praying for Brian and Daisy Hughes. They are a tremendous blessing to the work here in Fairbanks and the village ministries!! Pray that Brian can get off work to go out to Bethel with me in October.
