“Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, so that my house may be filled.” Luke 14:23

No matter how you try to get the Gospel out into the world, people always seem to think you are trying to jam religion down their throat. You can just mention it in passing, or you can preach on the street. Either way, you get the same response. The Czech Premier said that Global Warming was not science, but a religion. This religion is getting jammed down our throat. We had to put a Diesel Particle Filter on our van so that we could drive into the inner city. Religion is not cheap; it cost us \$1120 to put the filter on the car. We had to do it, or we could not go into the city to proclaim the Gospel. We had business in Berlin last week, so after it was finished we went to the German Reichstag, where hundreds of people were waiting to get in, and preached the Gospel there! What is good for the goose is good for the gander - we jammed our religion down their throat!

“Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith” Acts 14:22

As we mentioned in our last letter, we had a confirmation service for our son Daniel. At his birth we gave him the Ives verses Daniel 1:8 and Psalm 103:1-2. The services used these verses for a theme. The Lord brought many people to the services and it went very well. Three students from his school class came: Dennis, Sarah and Sophie. Our neighbors, the Hunger Family, came. Also another neighbor girl was able to join us. The Joeckel Family, whom we met over twelve years ago, came to church also for the very first time. The church's landlord, Manfred Moesch, also came with his wife Helga. The Lord gave us good services and spoke to hearts. Thank you for praying and please continue to pray for those who came.

“He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.” Mark 16:16 We used this verse as the theme for the services on “Pentecost”. The Germans do not have many national holidays, but they have many religious holidays. Pentecost is one of them. Nathalie, Tobias and Benjamin Schroeter followed the Lord in baptism on that Sunday. They have been saved, but were a bit scared of the water! After the Sunday morning service we went to Dresden's “Central Park” where there is a pond and had a baptismal service. Tom, one of Benny's school comrades, came with his mother along with Nadine. One of Nathalie's friends, Volker, who has been coming to church for quite some time, broke off his trip from Berlin to be in the services. Siggy was also there and had many questions. One good thing about outdoor baptisms is, there are always people who come by and listen to the services. So they are a public testimony in more ways than one. Please pray for all who were in attendance!

Alfreda and I continue to take our prayer walks daily. We have had some good talks with our neighbors. We have heard about some of the things that have occurred on our street in the past and often wish we had started this sooner. Prayer still has a preserving effect! We translated the tract “What Money Cannot Buy” and printed it in English and German, with the cover having a half of a fifty-dollar bill and half a fifty-euro. You should see how the people react to it. Also when we tell them we are praying for them daily there is always a good response. They never are blasphemous but instead are either silently thoughtful or thankful. It is good to be your deputies here!
